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PROGRAMS AND CURRICULUM 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR

SPROUTS (2 - 3 year olds)

Each class will have a maximum of 10 students. Students are NOT required to be toilet trained. Snack is provided by the school. This class uses the *Creative Curriculum*, participates in a Children and Worship program and a weekly music and movement class. The extended day program includes lunch, a rest time, snack, and a variety of activities to further enrich their day.

BUDS (3 - 4 year olds)

This program is for students who will be 3 by September 30th. Each class will have a maximum of 14 students. Students are required to be toilet trained. Snack is provided by the school. This class uses the *Creative Curriculum*, and is introduced to the *Handwriting Without Tears* Program. They also participate in Children and Worship and a weekly music and movement class. The extended day program includes lunch, a rest time, snack, and a variety of activities to further enrich their day.

BLOSSOMS (4 - 5 year olds)

This program is for students who will be 4 by September 30th. Each class will have a maximum of 14 students. Snack is provided by the school. This class uses the *Creative Curriculum* and *Handwriting Without Tears* program. They also participate in Children and Worship, a weekly music and movement class, and a weekly visit to our library. The extended day program includes lunch, a rest time, snack, and a variety of activities to further enrich their day.

KINDERGARTEN (5-6 year olds)

This full-day program is for students who will be 5 by September 30th. This class will have a minimum of 6 students and a maximum of 14 students. Within this class we will continue our dedication to nurturing the social, developmental, emotional and spiritual lives of our students. The curriculum for this class will closely follow that of the Montgomery Township School District, the NJ Core Curriculum Content Standards, and the Children and Worship program. Throughout the year, students will be focusing on Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, Art, Music, Library and Physical Education. Each student will receive personalized instruction at their own developmental and academic level, therefore establishing a strong foundation for the love of learning.

BEFORE & AFTER-CARE OPTIONS

Students enrolled in any program are welcome to join us prior and/or after class. This option is flexible. Days may be chosen based on each family's needs.

LUNCH OPTION

Students attending morning classes can join us for lunch. Parents provide lunch for their children. This is a wonderful opportunity for your child to have some social time with their friends while developing and practicing self-help skills at the lunch table. Students are taught how to manage their lunch boxes, open containers, help one another and use manners while socializing and enjoying their food. To assist those students with severe allergies, our campus is peanut free.

Afternoon Enrichment Program (2.5 - 6 year olds)

Each class will have a maximum of 14 students. Each session will be staffed by 1 teacher and 1 assistant. Through the course of the afternoon, students rotate among Activity Centers with a mixed-age group of friends. Each Activity Center will provide a wide range of possibilities such as: art exploration, science experiments, cooking projects, dramatics and pretend play, stories, music, snack, and outdoor activities.

- 1:00 - 3:00 (M-F)
 - Children do not need to be registered students to attend.
 - BVS students attending a morning class can extend the day by staying for lunch and afternoon enrichment. A 30-minute rest time is provided (1:00-1:30)
 - This program is designed to be flexible and requires only 24 hour notice for participation.
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Mom's Morning Out (2 - 6 year olds)

This program is available Monday-Friday mornings from 9:00-12:00 as needed with 24 hours' notice. We will provide a fun, loving program for your child while you have a morning to yourself. Activities include arts and crafts, dramatics and pretend play, stories, music, snack and outdoor time. Children do not need to be registered students to attend.
